Eureka Basin Field Trip Essentials

University provides:

- vans
- gasoline
- cooler

We share costs of:

- expendables, if necessary

We are each responsible for our own food

- There is absolutely *nothing* nearby. We must bring all food and water with us.
- You need *at very least*, breakfast for two days (Saturday & Sunday); lunch for three days: two days of travel (Friday & Sunday), and one day while field mapping (Saturday); dinner for two days (Friday & Saturday) If you bring no food with you, you will probably starve.
- We will bring a cooler or two for perishables on the trip out.

Things to bring: The weather may be very hot and/or very cold!:

- sleeping bag
- pad
- tent
- bug repellent (probably won't be a problem, but it's better to be prepared)
- ear plugs (Messina has been known to snore)
- warm clothing, including hat and gloves
- windbreaker, rain jacket
- sunscreen, sunglasses, sunhat
- hiking boots - we will be hiking all day on Saturday
- water bottle
- flashlight
- camera and film(!)
- incidental junk food, beverages, etc.

- Pencils with erasers, pens
- Notebook, field notebook, or clipboard
