How to find the bus!

By car: I-280 to 7th Street exit.
North 4 blocks, left on San Salvador,
2 blocks to Duncan Hall and the bus.
Parking in the garage at the corner
of 7th and San Salvador costs \$5.

Via public transportation: Light rail
and buses stop at 1st/2nd Streets
and Santa Clara/San Fernando,
about six blocks from Duncan Hall.
